

## Additional Information for Practitioners



***After a Cut is Properly Treated it is Possible to Use RED LED to Aid in the Internal Repair Process, Create More Collagen, and Reduce the Amount of Scar Tissue. The Protocol calls for Starting at One End of the Cut and Progressing to the End of the Cut. A motion of Back and Forth to be continued for less than 90 Seconds.***

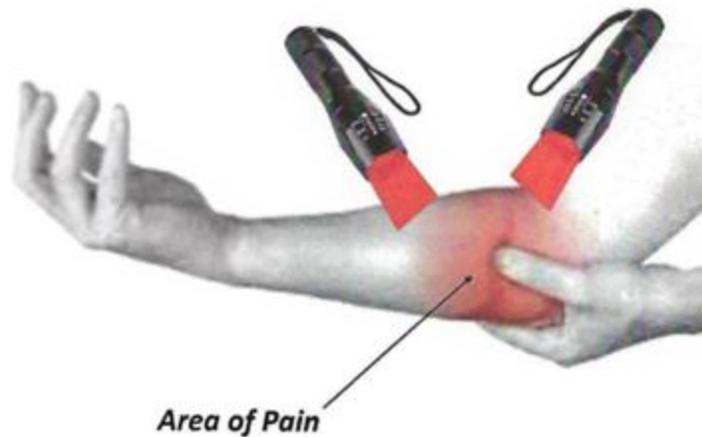


***Abrasion Therapy Using the RED LED allows for the Abrasion to Repair More Quickly and at a Faster Rate Than Normal.***

***Again Using a Back and Forth Motion the Entire Length of the Abrasion for no more than 90 Seconds.***

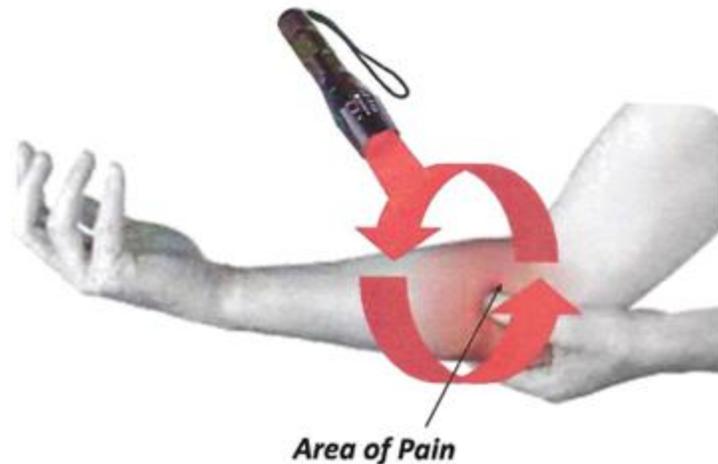
***In the Case of Surgical Areas You can Use the RED LED over the Bandaged Area, or Over the Area of the Scar Tissue; Once Again Use a Back and Forth Motion over the Area that Needs to be Aided in its Recovery Process for No More Than 90 Seconds.***

## ***Bridging of the Torches***



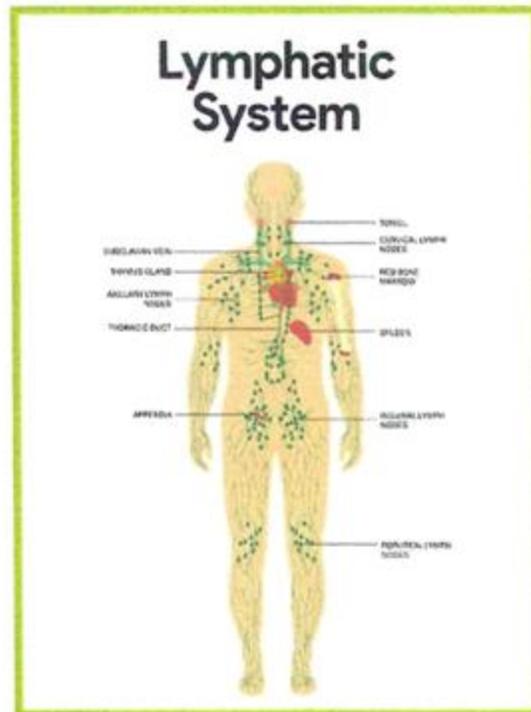
- Initially, locate the area of acute pain.
- Second, apply TWO RED LED Torches on Opposite ends of the affected area of pain.
- Both torches must be of the same rating, i.e., 660nm.
- Both torches are to be operated at the same time and for no more than 90 seconds in any one place.
- Remember to keep both torches as close to the skin as possible (preferably directly on the skin) to achieve the maximum result.

# ***Circling the Dragon***



- Circling the Dragon requires the use of one LED torch.
- Initially, locate the area of acute pain and apply the therapy torch for up to 90 seconds.
- Once the initial application has been accomplished, start to move the therapy torch in a circular motion around the center point of the painful or affected area.
- Keep the therapy torch as close to the surface of the skin (preferably, direct contact) as possible to achieve the greatest results.
- All LED therapy torches can be used in this manner, no matter the rating of the individual torch.
- All LED torches can be used in this manner, but do need to be of the same rating (i.e., RED, BLUE,

## ***Using the RED LED Torch for Aiding Lymphatic Drainage***



- **Using the RED LED Torch to Aid Lymphatic Drainage requires the RED LED Torch to be set to the First Flashing/Pulsing Setting and to be Used for NO MORE Than 90 Seconds at Any One Point. Keep the Torch as Close as Possible to the Skin.**
- **First Activate the Blood Vessels around the Specific Lymph Node You are Working With by Massaging Towards the Heart.**
- **Second Apply the RED LED Torch Directly on the Lymph Node You are Working With, Applying a Massaging Action, Towards the Heart, to Aid in the Movement of Fluids.**
